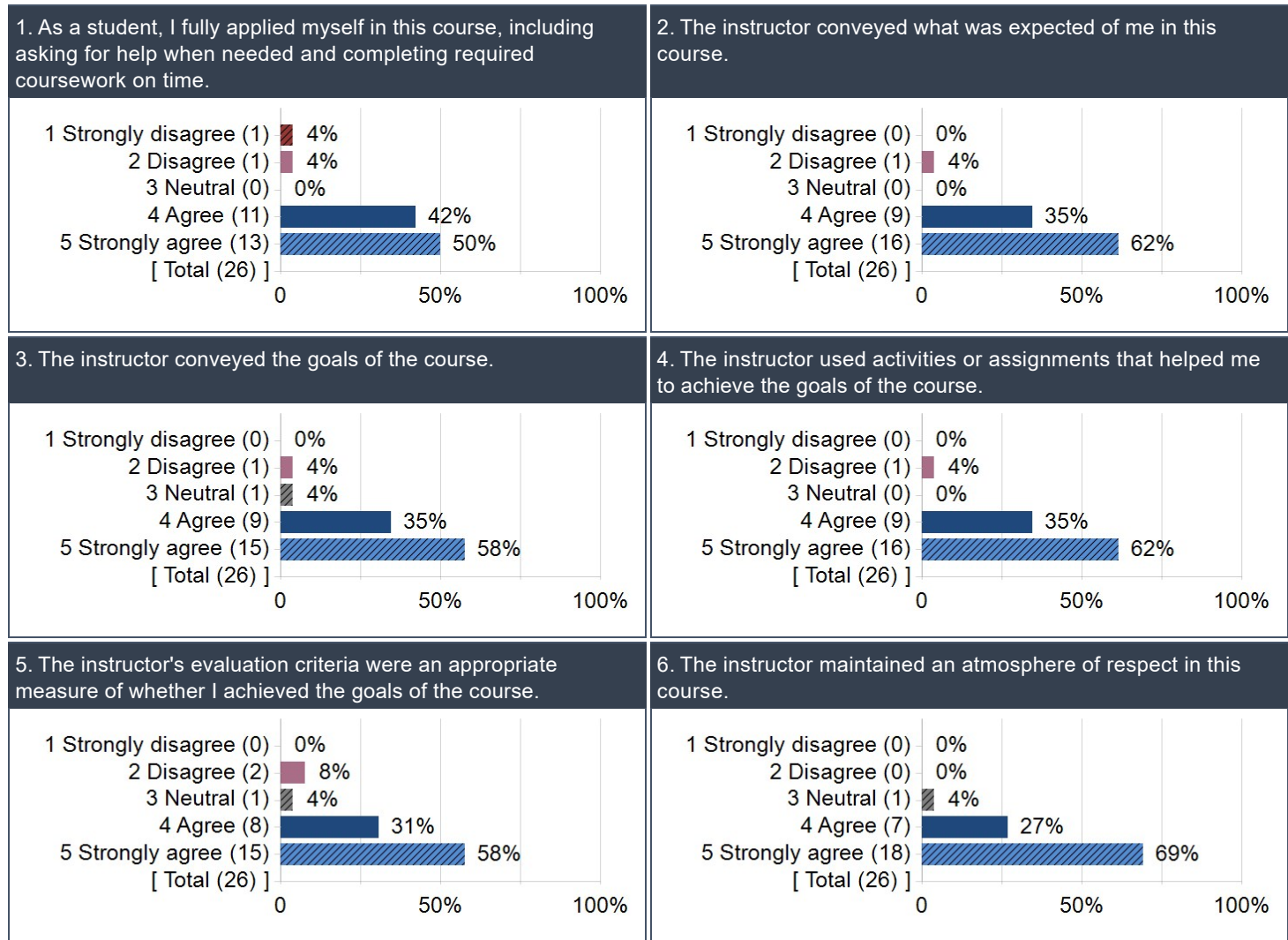

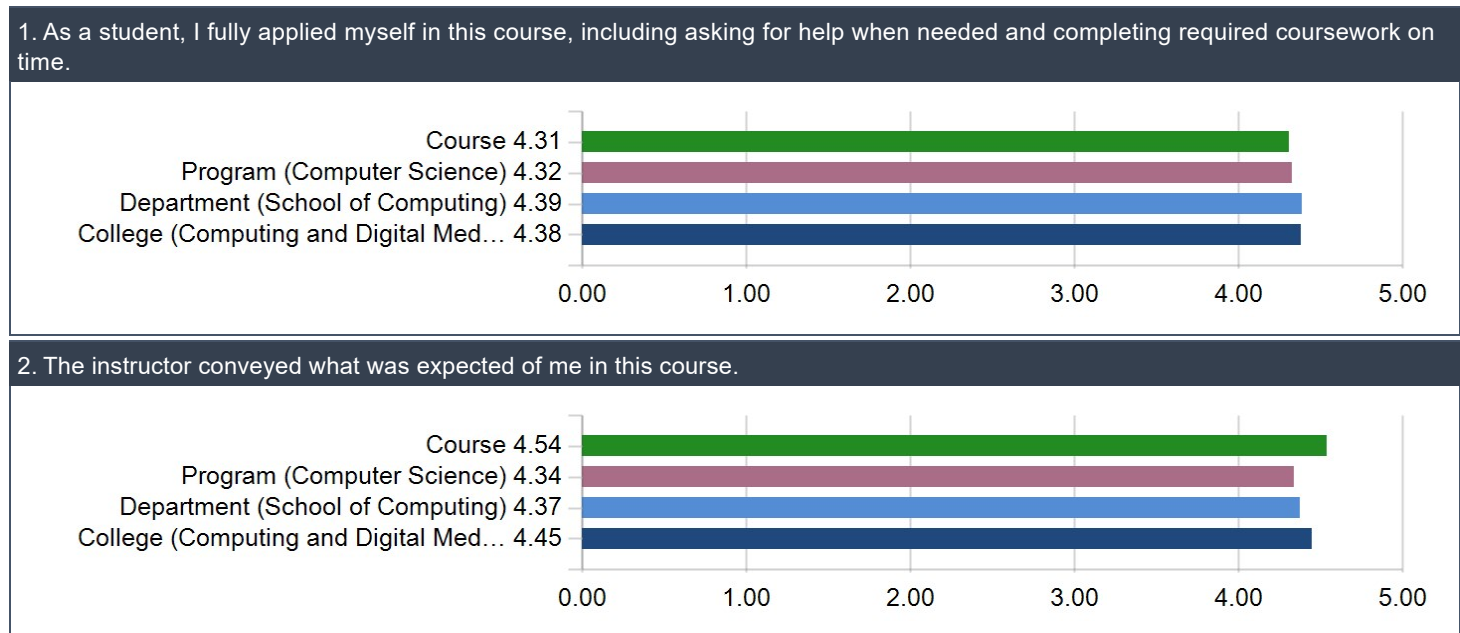

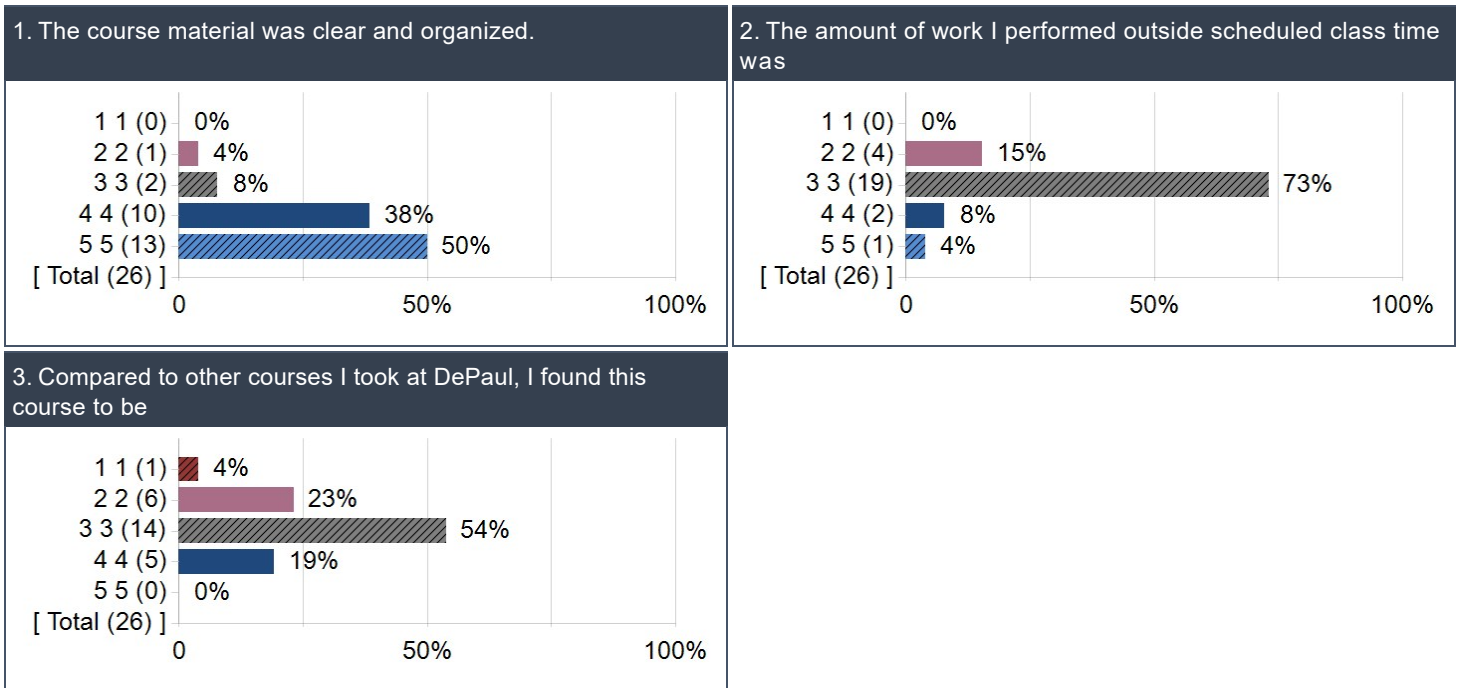

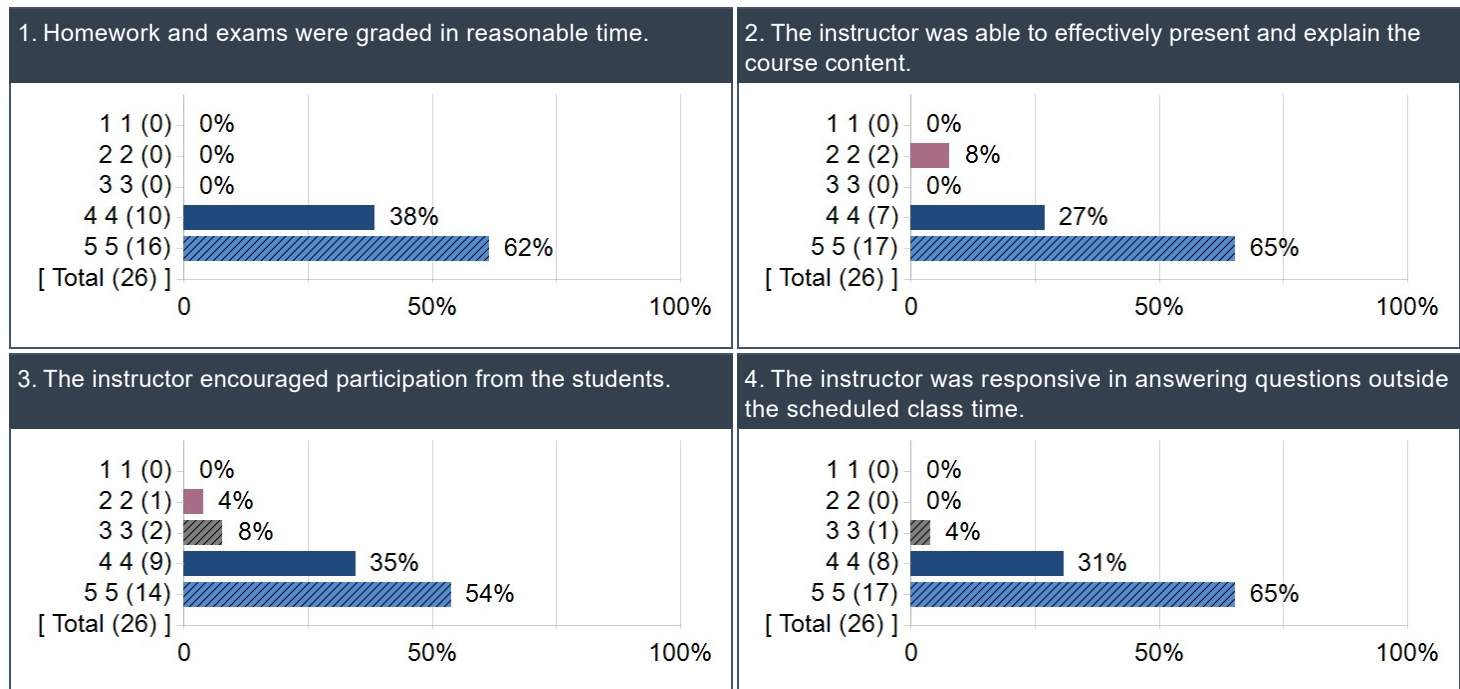

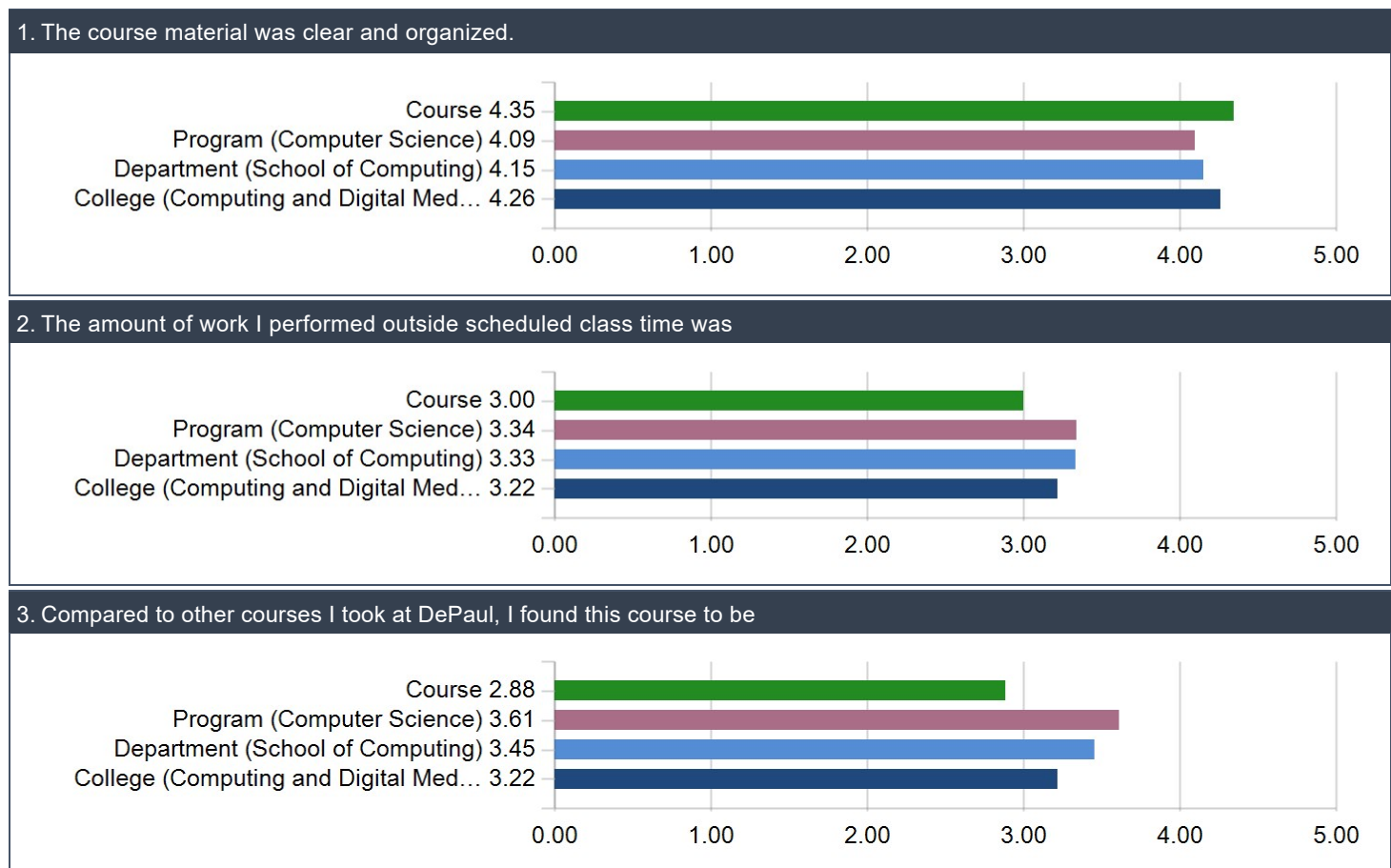
### Course Questions Frequency



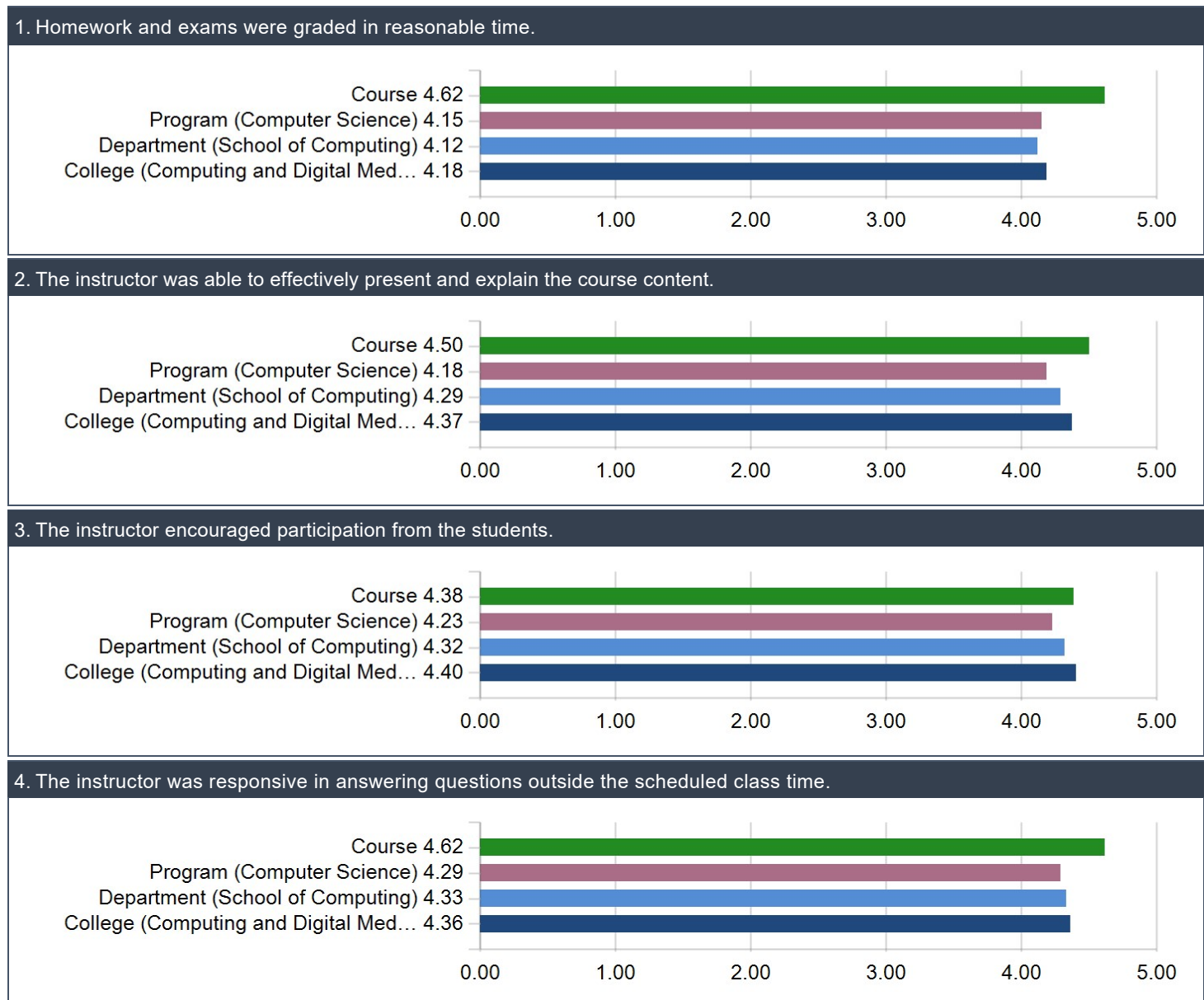
### Instructor Questions Frequency
